What's Next

After you drop your mare off, we will check her via ultrasound to see where she is at in her cycle. Depending on where she is in her cycle, we may either short cycle her, follow her, set her up, or breed her. After she is bred and ovulates, we will perform the first pregnancy check in two weeks. After that, we will follow her to heart beat which is usually another two weeks. After the mare is safe in foal, usually she is ready to go home at that time.

Communication is important to us - so we will try our best to communicate at all the major reproductive landmarks. Once you are notified that the mare is ready to go home, please call us at least a day before you come so that we can have everything ready in the office.

Please keep in mind that our staff goes to lunch between 12:00pm and 1:00pm. We have limited staff on the weekends so please make your arrangements during the week to schedule a special time to pick your mares up during the weekend.

We will not release your mare until your bill is paid in full.
