ONSITE FEES

PALPATION/EXAMINATION FEE: \$30.00 (each)	BOARDING: MARES
FROZEN SEMEN MANAGEMENT: \$200 CHARGED PER CYCLE	\$21.00 Dry \$23.00 Wet \$27.00 Special Care
FOALING OUT MARE: \$500.00 *We will call you as soon as possible following the birth of your foal*	

EMBRYO TRANSFER: Call 6666 Ranch for information regarding Embryo Transfer Services.

MARE: Required

Negative Coggins (within the last 12 months) and a Current Health Certificate

MARE: Recommended Pre-Foaling Program: Procedures will be performed if mare hasn't had them prior to foaling:

5, 7, 9 Month – Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino)

8,9 Month – Rotavirus

3-4 weeks prior to foaling:

Salmonella / Flu / Rhino / EEE, WEE / Tetanus / West Nile / Rotavirus / Rabies Deworming – Frequency and product determined by your veterinarian.

MARE: Recommended Post-Foaling Program: These procedures will be performed @ 6666 Ranch:

Caslicks (if necessary) / Float Teeth / Deworm

FOAL: Recommended Post-Foaling Program: These procedures will be performed post-foaling:

PLASMA (\$900.00 Estimated) 2 liters

The administration of 2 liters of plasma post-foaling will give your foal a much healthier start in life and provide it a greater level of immunity to ward off most neonatal infections. The plasma used at 6666 Ranch has been prepared to provide antibodies for the most common illnesses your foal may encounter.

Enema and medicate Naval at birth (No Charge) IgG within 24 hours of birth (\$51.25) CBC 7 days from birth (\$25.00)

VACCINATION SCHEDULE FOR FOALS

5,7,9 weeks of age – Lung ultrasound
9 weeks of age – Deworm with Anthelcide
16 weeks of age – (West Nile) (EEE/WEE/Tetanus/Rhino/ Flu) + Deworm with Strongid
20 weeks of age – (Flu / Rhino) (EEE/WEE/West Nile/Tetanus/Rabies) vaccine
28 weeks of age - EqStim

BREEDING/PREGNANCY STATUS:

Please provide us with your e-mail address on your contract or on the enclosed emergency care page and return it to this office and we will e-mail you regarding the status of your mare. If you leave without a pregnancy status, you will need to have your mare checked and report status to us. This is to ensure your mare is on the stallion breeding report.

PALPATION RISKS:

Rectal tears are an inherent risk of per-rectum clinical and reproductive examination. It is rare in incidence, but when it does happen it can be life threatening. Prompt medical and surgical intervention is required to improve patient outcome. We take every precaution to avoid rectal tears (proper restraint, and if needed: sedation, muscle relaxers, etc.). In the event of a rectal tear, we believe in communication and immediate treatment.

CONTAGIOUS DISEASE RISKS

We hold a high health care standard with stringent biosecurity. However, there is an inherent risk of your horse catching a contagious disease while around so many other horses. All precautions will be taken but in the event of an illness, we believe in communication and prompt treatment //quarantine.

DEPARTURE: Please call ahead to schedule the departure of your mare. All outstanding balances are due at this time with no exceptions.
